Timeline

The applications will be accepted March 21, 2023 through April 21, 2023 with scholarship winners announced in May 2023.

The goal of this scholarship is to support the educational/career plans of a graduating elementary student or high school senior who has demonstrated a commitment to personal integrity, ethics, and community service.

1) Eligibility Details:

- Applicants must **reside** and be a permanent resident of Norwood Park at the time of application.
 - NOW OPEN TO: Oriole Park, Big Oaks & Union Ridge (limitations: from Higgins Ave to Nagle Ave to Gunnison St.) MUST be a Chicago Resident. Please email us at <u>info@norwoodpark.org</u> if you have questions about whether you qualify.
- Applicants must show proof of residency and school transcripts
- Applicant must submit a completed application on or before 7pm on March 31, 2022.

2) Applicant requirements:

- Applicants must currently be students in good standing in Elementary or High School
- Applicants must be graduating in 2023 and be either in 8th grade elementary school or be a high school senior
- Applicants must be enrolling in a high school, community college, university/college, or postsecondary (technical or trade) degreed program for the first term following graduation.
- Applications must be received by 7:00 p.m. on April 21, 2023. Only applications completed in entirety will be considered.
- Must have copies of school info including current GPA, Class Rank, Test Scores
- Applicants may share awards, volunteerism, employment and recommendation letters
- Awarded funds may be used to assist with student expenses such as tuition, fees, books or room and board. Funds will be made payable directly to school of winner's choice.

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Awards

1. A total of three (3) scholarships will be awarded. 1st place will receive \$1,500. 2nd place will receive \$1,000 and 3rd place will receive \$500.

2. Scholarships will be awarded May 2023 and made payable any time after June 15, 2023, upon receipt of definite proof of enrollment in a high school, community college, university/college, or post-secondary school (technical or trade) degreed program.

3. A committee comprised of officers and directors of the Norwood Park Chamber Scholarship Committee reviews and evaluates all applications submitted.

4. A copy of the letter from the high school, college, university, or trade school indicating the applicant's acceptance into a program of study in the Fall of 2023 must be provided prior to disbursement of funds.

- 2. Attach an official high school transcript or most current grammar school report card
- 3. Attach proof of residency
- 4. Attach (2) Personal Reference forms from a non-family member
- 5. Typed, double-spaced, 500-word essay on the following topic:

TOPIC: Pick a role model that you believe shows strong leadership. What makes them stand out to you and how have they influenced you as you develop your leadership style?
